



**Information under the provisions of the legislative decree n. 196 of 30 June 2003,
"Data Protection Code"**

Dear Customer

The undersigned WORLD TRADE SPA, holder of your personal data, according to the provisions of article 13 of the legislative decree n.196 of 30.6.2003, informs as to the following regarding personal data supplied by you for the management of our present contractual relations. Personal data gathered and treated by the undersigned falls into one of the following categories:

1. identifying data (company name, offices, tel., fax, email, fiscal details, etc.);
2. data relative to economical and commercial activity (orders, solvency, bank details, accounts and fiscal details, etc.).

Personal data provided by you will be used within the limits of and for the pursuit of the aims relative to the present contractual relations. In particular such processing is aimed at the relative and consequent fulfilment of carrying out all administrative, commercial, accounting and fiscal activities. Supplying data and its subsequent processing is compulsory in relation to the relative aims of fulfilment of a contractual and legal nature. Supplying the data is also to be considered compulsory for the fulfilment of all the undersigned's activities necessary and useful for carrying out contractual obligations. If data for such purposes should be refused then it could be impossible for the undersigned to get contractual relations and law obligations under way. Supplying data is however optional for sending communications or advertising material which our company can do using your email address or fax number. You can oppose such processing at any time by sending a request via email or fax to the numbers below. Any refusal to provide data for marketing purposes will not jeopardise the regular carrying out of present contractual relations.

Personal data provided by you will be treated in "a lawful and correct way", according to the provisions of article 11 of the legislative decree n. 196 of 30 June 2003.

Processing will involve the use of paper, computerised and telecommunication devices. Only authorised persons, such as those responsible for administration, marketing and data processing systems management and maintenance, will have access to and therefore know your data.

Subject to communications carried out to fulfil law and contractual obligations, all data received and elaborated can be communicated within Italy and transferred abroad solely for the above mentioned purposes to:

1. societies offering services, data elaboration, accounts/ fiscal consultation and generally all bodies which check and test as regards the correct fulfilment of the above mentioned purposes;
2. any person external to our structure, with whom we have stipulated agreements as regards measures to be adopted for guaranteeing the security of data entrusted to them, in any case the data will be treated solely for the pursuit of the above mentioned aims.

The controller of data processing is **WORLD TRADE SPA**

You can exercise your rights as stated in article 7 of the legislative Decree n. 196 of 30 June 2003 at any time. They are as follows:

Personal data access right and others

1. The interested party has the right to receive confirmation that the personal data regarding himself exists, even if not yet registered, and such communication should be in a comprehensible form.
2. the interested party has the right to receive indication of :
 - a. the origin of the personal data;
 - b. the purpose and modalities of the processing;
 - c. the logic applied when processing is carried out using electronic devices;
 - d. the identifying details of the holder, those in charge and the designated representative according to the provisions of article 5, paragraph 2;
 - e. the individuals or groups of individuals to whom the personal data can be communicated or who can come into contact with it as designated representative in the State territory, those in charge or charged with the job.
3. The interested party has the right to obtain:
 - a. the update, correction, or when necessary, the integration of the data;
 - b. the cancellation, transformation into anonymous form or blockage of data treated in violation of the law, including that which is not necessary to conserve in relation to the aims for which the data has been collected and subsequently treated;
 - c. the attestation that operations a) and b) have been brought to the attention, also as regards their content, of whom the data has been communicated or divulged, except for the case in which such fulfilment is revealed impossible or implies the use of means obviously out of proportion to the right being defended.
4. the interested party has the right to fully or partially oppose himself:
 - a. for reasons legitimate to treating personal data which regard him, even if pertinent to the aim of collecting;

to processing personal data related to sending advertising material or direct sales or market research or commercial communications.
